### A SLIT-RING, JUE, WESTERN ZHOU

Lacquer or fabric coated bronze. China, Western Zhou, 10<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> century BC

Of circular form, pierced with a hole in the center with a slit through the edge, one side incised with a stylized dragon. With extensive signs of weathering and malachite-green encrustation.

Compare a related jue, carved from Jade, from the Western Zhou at Bonhams New York in Fine Chinese Paintings and Works of Art on 21 July 2020, lot 87, **sold for USD 15,075** (part lot, together with a late Shang/early Western Zhou dynasty pendant.
