A CARVED BAMBOO FIGURE OF AN IMMORTAL

China, Qing Dynasty (1644-1912). Carved, standing and smiling with a characteristically incised flowing beard, with the right hand raised and holding a book, dressed in a long, layered robe. The natural beauty of the material especially visible on the backside, overall bearing a fine reddish-brown patina.
