A LARGE ANDO STYLE GINBARI CLOISSONÉ VASE

Japan, Taisho to early Showa period (1921-1945)

The baluster-shaped vase decorated with colored enamels and silver wire with a flowering prunus as well as various other flowers and birds, all on a punched red foil ground which also features a bird and bamboo stalks. The rim on the mouth and underside silver plated, the latter houses the mark 'made in Japan'.
