A CLOISSONNÉ ENAMEL 'FLORAL' VASE

Japan, Meiji period (1868-1912)

The baluster vase decorated in silver wires and polychrome enamels on a midnight blue ground with pink and white peonies amid their leaves and tendrils. The rims and underside applied with copper.
