A CLOISONNÉ ENAMEL 'DRAGON' BOWL

Japan, Meiji period (1868-1912)

The midnight blue bowl decorated with colored enamels and silver wire with a three-clawed sinuous dragon along the sides. The interior showing a dense composition of flowers including cherry blossom and wisteria. The lip, foot rim and base applied with copper.

DIAMETER 12.5 cm
