A SMALL CLOISONNÉ ENAMEL VASE WITH CRANES

Japan, Taisho period (1921-1926)

The baluster-shaped vase worked in silver wire and colored enamels to depict two red hooded cranes in flight against a midnight blue ground. The rim on the mouth and underside applied with silvered brass. Marked to the underside's rim CLOISONNE.

Condition: Small imperfections and faults, minor surface scratches, few hairlines, and surface wear.
